

INFORMATION ON COLLARS AND HARNESSES

A greyhound's neck is as wide as its head and a collar can therefore easily slip over the ears if the dog walks backwards (unexpectedly), for example. A suitable collar is very important. Purchase a wide collar, as the greyhound has a long neck. Always make sure the material is good and that the rings used are "welded" and therefore cannot bend open. Below we explain a few things. All items are available through GINN. GINN and SalukiHope work together and therefore we would like to refer to their site https://greyhoundsinnood.nl/winkel/. Here you will find the collars, harnesses etc described below. Martingale bands:

This band should be loose around the neck but tight behind the ears once tension from the tightened leash is applied. The 2 rings should not touch each other when tension is put on the strap by normal belt pulling (see the 5th picture). Never buy a too wide belt and always make sure you can fit.

Available in leather (these are not adjustable, have fixed sizes and will be fitted to the dog on arrival) or fabric (these are available in our webshop in 2 sizes and are widely adjustable)





There are various designs and price ranges, we recommend our safety harnesses; fully adjustable by means of sliding buckles, clip fasteners with safety pin, three-point fastening: around the neck, behind the front legs and behind the ribs so that the dog cannot escape from the harness in any way in case of unexpected movements, available in our webshop.





Police strap:

These are used for double leash on collar and harness but can also be worn around waist or crosswise over shoulder. They have a length of 3 metres, double-stitched nylon, 2 stainless steel musketon hooks with strong spring and fit perfectly with our harnesses, also available in our webshop.

Short belt:

In combination with police strap for double leash, attach to collar, have a length of 130 cm, double-stitched nylon with sturdy musketon.





Wrist strap:

The wristband is made of braided tunnel cord, is very strong and ideal to use with our harness and leash.

Handy if you do want to grab your keys or look at your mobile during a walk, a reassuring thought, your dog is safe at all times!

Gps tracker:



A collar with a tracker can be an aid to keep an extra eye on your dog but never offers 100% security!
